KEYNOTE SPEAKER: ESTER J DE JONG

Ester J. de Jong is a Professor in ESOL/Bilingual Education and the Director of the School of Teaching and Learning. She teaches courses in bilingual and bicultural education and in curriculum, methods, and assessment for English speakers of other languages. Prior to academia, she worked for the Framingham public schools in Massachusetts as the Assistant Director for Bilingual Education and ESL programs. Her research focuses on two-way bilingual education, language-in-education policy, and mainstream teacher preparation for bilingual students. Her book "Foundations for Multilingualism in Education: From Principles to Practice" (Caslon Publishing, 2011) looks at principles for quality schooling for bilingual learners. Dr. de Jong was the 2017-2018 President of TESOL International Association.
